- Cares to work **safely and responsibly**;
- Enjoys working in a **creative and inventive** way;
- Is **proactive and reliable**;
- Cultivates their own **spiritual practice**;
- Has a valid **driver's license** (ideally);
- Is ready to make a long-term **commitment** of multiple months and ideally a year;
- Is **motivated** to be of service for 6 hours a day 5 days a week.

Being a Maintenance Volunteer means to:

- **Flexibly** alternate between a wide variety of tasks;

- Be present on the ground to **decisively** and **flexibly** act upon immediate demands, such as repairing outdoor lights due to heavy weather;
- Find **creative and inventive solutions** using the available resources at hand;
- **Closely synergize** with the team coordinator and other team members;
- **Work outdoors** throughout both incredible and challenging weather conditions;
- Adhere to policies to work in **efficient and safe** ways;
- Be proactive in **organizing the tools and maintenance workshop**;
- Execute **recurring tasks**, such as maintaining the compost toilets and providing firewood in winter;
- **Be part of a purposeful project!**

As a volunteer, your food and accommodation will be provided. In exchange, you are of service for 6 hours a day 5 days a week, and contribute 10 euro a day. We ask for a contribution to sustain the financial health of this beautiful project.
