- Knows how to set priorities amid a **dynamic workflow**;
- Has knowledge of **safety** regulations and procedures;
- Enjoys working in a **creative and inventive** way;
- Is proactive, **organized**, and reliable;
- Cultivates their own **spiritual practice**;
- Knows how to use Google tools;
- Has a valid driver's license;
- Is ready to **commit** for a year (minimum is 6 months);
- Is **motivated** to be of service for 6 hours a day 5 days a week.

Being a Maintenance Coordinator means to:

- Be present on the ground to **decisively act** upon immediate demands, such as repairing outdoor lights due to heavy weather;

- Continuously **balance** those immediate demands with continued progress on longer-term priorities;
- Coordinate the maintenance team and its volunteers, providing **guidance and instructions**.
- Find creative and inventive **solutions** using the available resources at hand;
- **Closely synergize** with other team coordinators;
- **Work outdoors** throughout both incredible and challenging weather conditions;
- Create and implement policies to work in **efficient and safe** ways;
- Being in charge of the **budget** and maintenance-related purchases, and using Google tools to keep track;
- Taking the lead in **organizing** the **tools and maintenance workshop**;
- Coordinate and/or execute **recurring tasks** such as maintaining the compost toilets and providing firewood in winter;
- **Be part of a purposeful project!**

As a coordinating volunteer, your food and accommodation will be provided. Additionally, you will receive a contribution of 250 euros monthly. In exchange, you are at service for 30 hours a week.
