

## Agriculture Lead

**We are currently looking for a passionate Agriculture Lead, who feels called to serve Ananda Kalyani by managing our agriculture team. The Lead guides daily operations of our food production - providing nourishing food for people who work and live on the land, while growing it into a sustainable business.**

Ananda Kalyani is a pioneering project dedicated to spirituality, local development, and holistic regeneration, encompassing environmental, economic, and social aspects. We aim to serve as a model and educational hub for sustainable and regenerative living in the 21st century.

Joining us, means living amid astonishing nature, getting access to inspiring knowledge and visions of a regenerative world, joining spiritual practices such as kirtan and meditation, and receiving spiritual teachings and support from spiritual guides through your inner and outer journey.

You will find 3 hectares of organic certified production, including 0.5 hectares of vegetables, 1.5 hectares of cherry and mixed orchards, 0.5 hectares of berries, and an additional 0.5 hectares of diverse orchards spread throughout the land, giving around 3 tons of production yearly.

### **Ideally, someone who:**

- Is inspired by serving a **higher purpose** through farming;
- Believes in the importance of **sustainable farming** as one of the pillars for a healthy society;
- Has **experience in farming** and is passionate about the **lifestyle** that it entails;
- Has knowledge of **farming systems**, such as the irrigation system;
- Wants to live long term in this region, since it is on-site work;
- Has a strong **ability to lead**: guiding, motivating, and managing a team;
- Communicates clearly and effectively within the team, project, and beyond;
- Is capable of basic **accounting work** to keep track of production, costs, and revenues,
- Brings an **entrepreneurial spirit** to co-create the next phase in our food production project and help design a better utilization of our farmland.

### Being an Agriculture Lead means to:

- Be a **farmer** and a **manager** at the same time;
- Lead and manage the **daily operations** of the agriculture team (currently 3 - 4 people, with potential to grow);
- Coordinate and actively participate in farming tasks: planning, planting, maintenance, harvesting, and post-harvest work;
- Do **office work** to keep track of production, interventions, and accounting to present to the Organic Certifier entity;
- Fix problems in the irrigation system (both plumbing and electrical) or other support systems in a farm;
- Design and implement improved methods for food production that are both environmentally and financially sustainable.
- Have the opportunity to learn directly from the previous Agriculture Team Lead through continuous mentoring, ensuring a smooth transition and valuable knowledge transfer.

As a Team Lead, your food and accommodation will be provided. Additionally, you will receive a contribution of 250 euros monthly. In exchange, you are at service for 30 hours a week.
